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MakeDoc - Installation Manual

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1. Preface

MakeDoc generates HTML, PDF and DOCX documentation for TIBCO BusinessWorks[™], TIBCO BusinesEvents®, TIBCO iProcess projects and TIBCO EMS servers.

This document specifies the system requirements and the MakeDoc installation process.

Potential problems and their solutions are described in the *User's Guide* document, which can be found at www.makedoc.com.







2. Minimal Requirements

- Java(TM) 2 Runtime Environment 1.6 (J2SE)
- The latest version is available at http://java.sun.com
- 2GB RAM





3. Additional Requirements

- **TIBCO BusinessEvents 1.3 or higher** must be installed on your machine to document projects using BusinessEvents items.
- **TIBCO Runtime Agent 5.3 or higher** must be on your machine to document projects stored in a remote server repository.
- TIBCO BusinessWorks[™] 5.1 or higher

Only projects created in version 5.1 or higher are supported.

• TIBCO EMS 6.x or 7.x

Only servers in version 6.x or 7.x are supported.







4. Installation

Chapter describes step by step installation and configuration of MakeDoc.





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4.1. Unzip

MakeDoc has no installer. Recommended directory structure for MakeDoc looks like this:

- **\$MAKEDOC_ROOT** (eg. C:\MakeDoc)
 - **\$MAKEDOC_ROOT/bin** (binaries MakeDoc archive content goes here)
 - **\$MAKEDOC_ROOT/cfg** (configuration directory choose this when prompted for configuration directory path by MakeDoc configuration wizard)
 - **\$MAKEDOC_ROOT/ws** (workspace directory choose as workspace location dialog when running MakeDoc)





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4.2. First Run

Run MakeDoc.exe file (MakeDoc runnable file on Linux) from the location where you extracted distribution binaries (typically C:\MakeDoc\bin). When prompted select directory for MakeDoc workspace. This is the place where all MakeDoc projects will be stored (C:\MakeDoc\ws)

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4.3. Configuration Wizard

It is necessary to go through initial configuration process when running MakeDoc for the first time. MakeDoc provides configuration wizard which is launched automatically when no configuration is located on target machine. To install MakeDoc it is neccessary to accept License agreenment. Then to configure MakeDoc just follow the instructions on the screen. Some steps are optional. Further configuration or some settings changes can be done using configuration dialog **Window -> Preferences -> MakeDoc**. You can also completely reconfigure MakeDoc by running configuration wizard at any time using **Help -> Reconfigure MakeDoc**.







5. Uninstallation

To uninstall MakeDoc all you need to do is delete MakeDoc directory structure.
